


# Annotate a pdf file with iPocket Draw

- Click on the icon : 
- Click on « Annotate a pdf » and choose the pdf to annotate
- The current drawing is saved and closed


- All pages of the pdf are displayed with a zoom all command :



Here it is a 2 pages pdf, one in landscape and one in portrait.

- You can now annotate the pdf by using all drawing functions of iPocket Draw over the original pdf drawing.

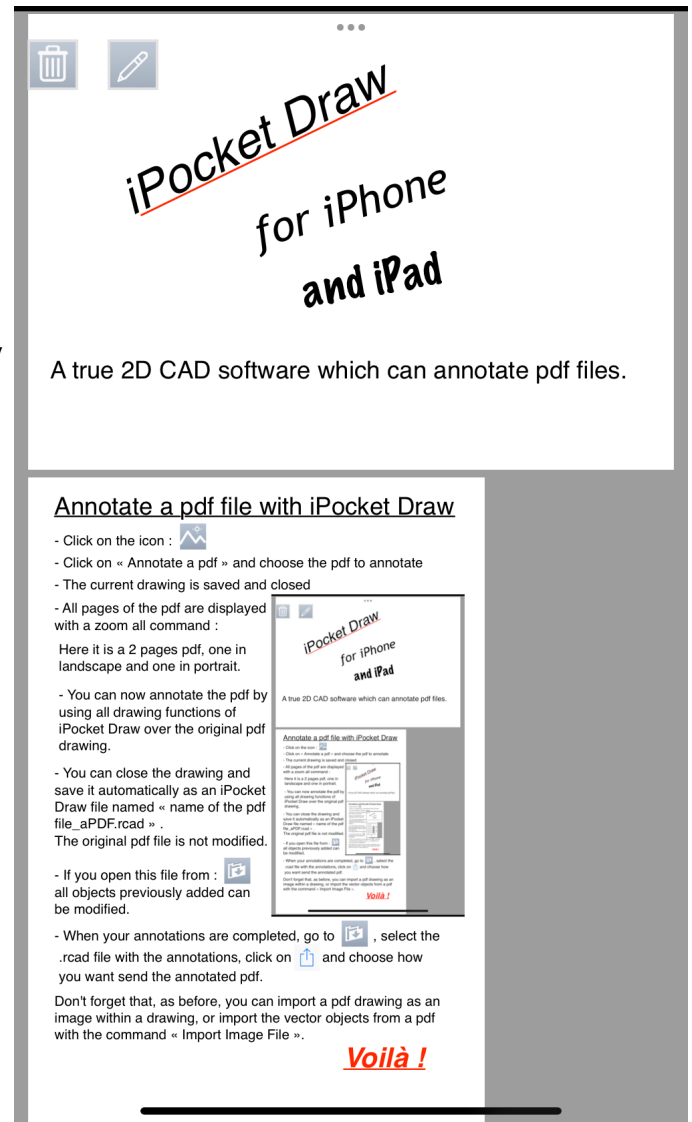
- You can close the drawing and save it automatically as an iPocket Draw file named « name of the pdf file\_aPDF.rcad » .

The original pdf file is not modified.

- If you open this file from :  all objects previously added can be modified.

- When your annotations are completed, go to  , select the .rcad file with the annotations, click on  and choose how you want send the annotated pdf.

Don't forget that, as before, you can import a pdf drawing as an image within a drawing, or import the vector objects from a pdf with the command « Import Image File ».
